### **Questions**

1. By what was Paul an apostle? (Verse 1)
  
2. Write down what you think “Spiritual blessings” spoken of in verse 3 might be? The word spiritual means non-carnal, supernatural, relating to the human spirit or rational soul.
  
3. In verse 4, consider the word “chosen”. Read also 1 Corinthians 1:27 where this same greek word is used. Write your thoughts.
  
4. Paraphrase verse 13 in your own words.
  
5. According to verses 15,16 what did Paul do after he heard of their faith?

6. What was Paul's prayer found in verses 17 & 18?

7. According to verses 19, 20 how did God show His mighty power?

8. What is the position/place that Jesus holds?

## Ephesians Chapter 2

### Questions

1. Who do you think the Prince of the air is? Read also John 12:27-32.

2. According to verses 8 & 9, how are you saved from hell? Why not of works?

3. Throughout verses 11-18 Paul uses the phrase “both”, who is he speaking of?

4. What *were* we? What *are* we now, because of Christ? (Verse 19)

## Ephesians Chapter 3 Questions

1. According to verses 3-6 what is the mystery that was not made known to other ages, but is now revealed to us?
2. Verse 10 speaks of the church understanding the principalities and powers. What do we do with this knowledge? Give me a scripture reference for why you think that?
3. Paul says that we have boldness and access with confidence now. How do we possess this?
4. Verses 16-19 is a prayer for the saints. Please paraphrase this prayer with your own understanding.

## **Ephesians Chapter 4**

### **Questions**

1. In verse 1 Paul is encouraging them to walk worthy of the vocation wherewith they were called. What is your vocation?
2. How should you walk in that vocation according to verse 2?
3. What callings did the Lord give in verse 11? Why (vs 12-16)?
4. According to verses 17-19 how did the Gentiles walk?
5. How are we as Christ's followers told to walk? (verses 20-32)

## Ephesians Chapter 5

### Questions

1. According to verse 1 how are we to be followers of Christ?
2. Why do you think that the writer tells us to give thanks rather than engage in all of the sinful actions mentioned in verses 3,4?
3. What are we *not* supposed to let happen? (verse 6,7)
4. According to verses 8 what WERE you and what ARE you now? Why?

5. Please rewrite verses 17-21 in your own words.

6. Read verses 22-24, what does this look like in your home if you are married? If not married, how do you envisioning this looking?
